## A. CSR Initiatives

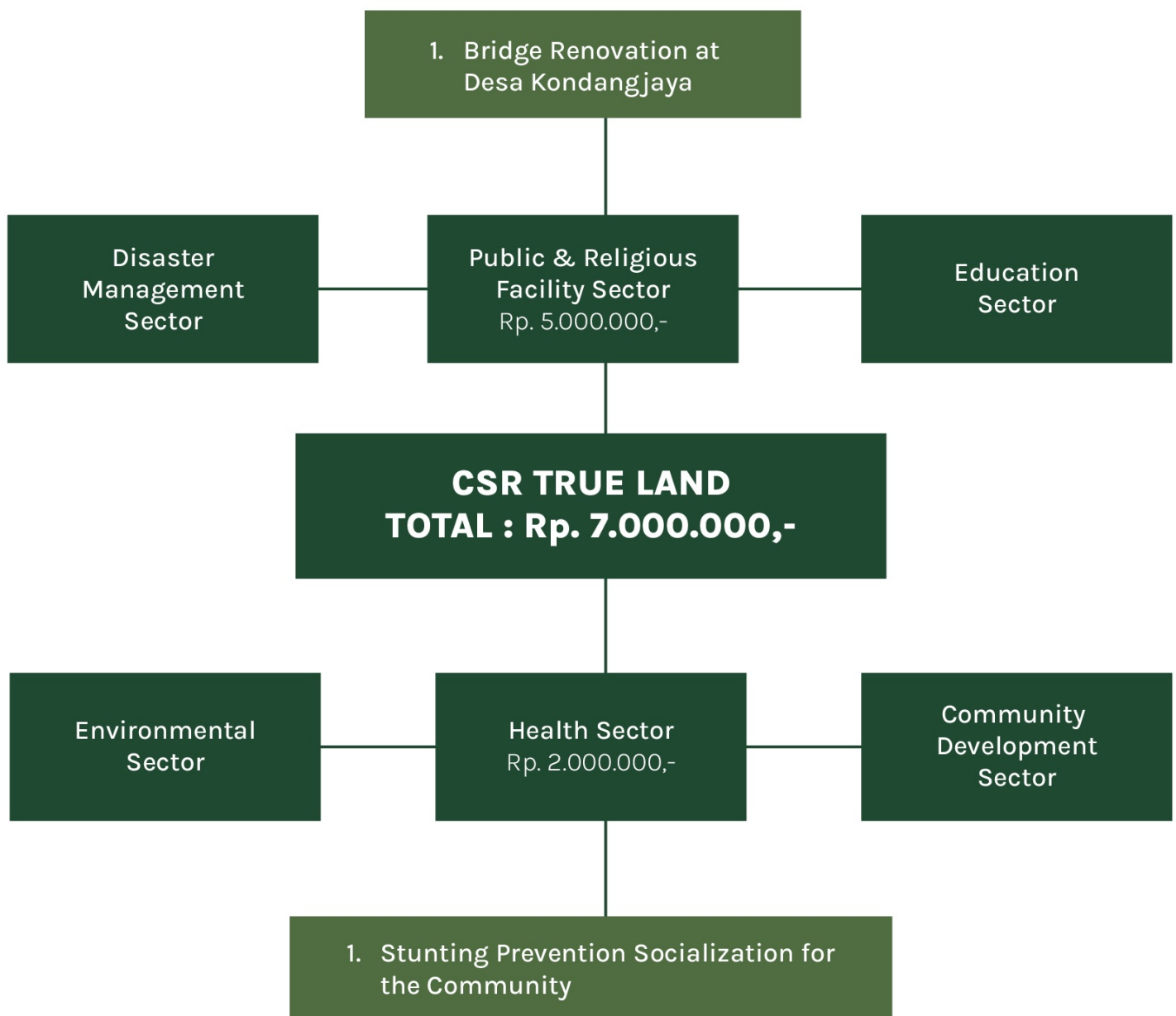
We believe that the business sector has a significant impact on society and the environment, making our commitment to Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) essential.

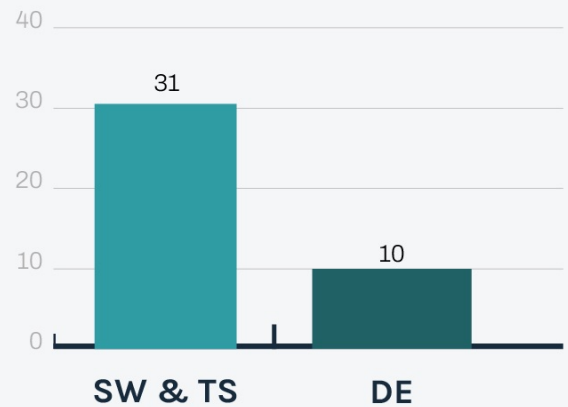


# TRINITY DINAMIK'S RESOURCE UTILIZATION OVERVIEW

## PAPER USAGE BY PROJECT (REAM)

The chart beside this displays the paper usage for each project under Trinita Dinamik. The data shows that total paper usage reached 41 reams in Q1 2026. Currently, the Springwood Residence (SW) and The Smith (TS) projects combined are the largest contributors, with a total paper usage of 31 reams. Meanwhile, the District East (DE) project recorded a paper usage of 10 reams.

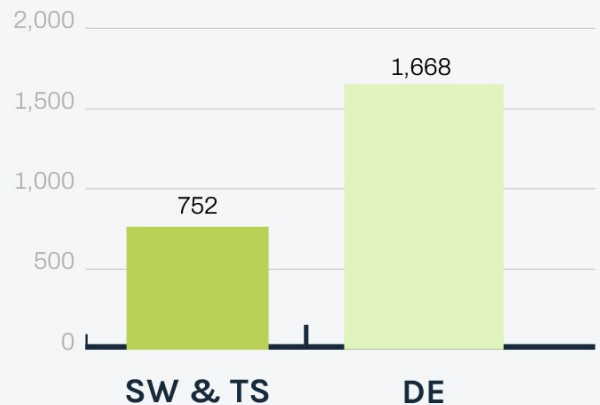
• Paper Usage Chart (in reams)



## FUEL USAGE BY PROJECT (LITER)

The chart on the side illustrates fuel consumption by Trinita Dinamik and its projects. The chart indicates that total fuel consumption in Q1 2026 reached 2.420 liters. Furthermore, it shows that combined fuel usage at District East was the highest, amounting to 1.668 liters. This was due to numerous exhibitions held outside the projects, which led to more frequent use of office vehicles.

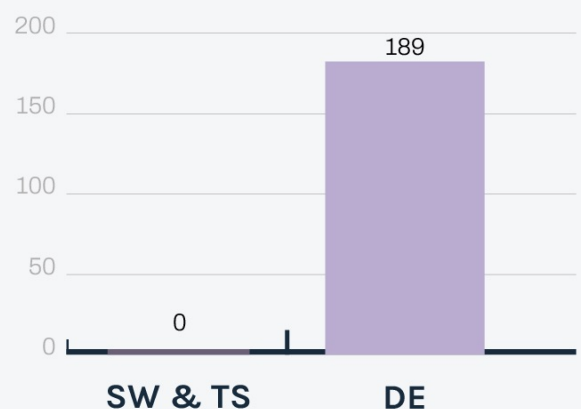
• Fuel Usage Chart (in reams)



## ELECTRICITY USAGE BY PROJECT (KWH)

The chart on the side illustrates the electricity usage by Trinita Dinamik and its projects. In Q1 2026, electricity consumption was recorded only for District East (DE), which amounted to 189 kWh, while no electricity usage was recorded for Springwood Residence (SW) and The Smith (TS) during the same period.
