Company at Brief



PT Triniti Dinamik Tbk is a real estate and property developer company in Indonesia. Since the establishment in 2014, two major projects are Springwood Residence with 1400 units and The Smith that consists of Office, SOHO, and Residential with 652 units. After successfully building two High Rise Building projects, the Company is currently developing landed houses that are integrated with the area, namely the District East project located in East Karawang with a land area of around 26 Ha.

One of the strengths of Triniti Dinamik is the fast speed selling capability. Springwood Residence was able to be sold out in less than 6 (six) months. As for The Smith's sales, until the end of 2023 has reached 85%. PT Triniti Dinamik Tbk is part of PT Perintis Triniti Properti Tbk who also developed projects in Alam Sutera including: Brooklyn, Yukata Suites, and Collins Boulevard, with the total project value amounted to nearly US\$1 billion.

The Company is supported by professional Management who is able to provide high quality premium and high-class project. With the certification of ISO 9001, proper quality system and corporate good governance have been implemented strictly. Therefore, the majority of customers remain satisfied with what has been delivered by the Company through its projects.

What We Do?

At Triniti Dinamik, we are committed to implementing a comprehensive approach to sustainability that encompasses several key aspects:

a. CSR Impact

We believe that the business sector has a significant impact on society and the environment, making our commitment to Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) essential. Triniti Dinamik has implemented all six CSR pillars with a total value of IDR80,996,670. We have taken strategic steps to create a positive impact across various areas, including social welfare, environmental conservation, diversity and inclusion, public health, and education. In this report, we will highlight various initiatives and partnerships that demonstrate our commitment to these important issues.

b. ESG Efforts

Our focus on Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) aspects is central to our sustainability journey. We recognize the importance of responsible resource management and have implemented significant measures to reduce our ecological footprint. Our initiatives include the efficient use of paper, with a total consumption of 136 reams in Q3 2025, along with the consumption of 7.187 liters of fuel and 2.172.996 kWh of electricity during the same period. These efforts are supported by rigorous waste management practices to further minimize our environmental impact.



Paper Usage by Project


(Ream)



The adjacent chart illustrates the paper usage of each project under Triniti Dinamik. As of Q3 2025, total paper consumption reached 136 reams. Combined, the Springwood Residence (SW) and The Smith (TS) projects account for the largest share, totaling 103 reams, while the District East (DE) project recorded 33 reams. The higher paper usage in TS and SW is attributed to ongoing sales and handover processes that are still taking place as of Q3 2025, whereas DE has only begun its construction phase in mid-2025.

Fuel Usage by Project


(Liter)



The chart on the side illustrates fuel consumption by Triniti Dinamik and its projects. The chart indicates that total fuel consumption until Q3 2025 reached 7.186 liters. Furthermore, it shows that combined fuel usage at Springwood Residence (SW) and The Smith (TS) was among the highest, amounting to 3.305 liters. This was due to numerous exhibitions held outside the projects, which led to more frequent use of office vehicles. Meanwhile, District East (DE) recorded higher fuel consumption than TS and SW, driven by the mobility required for intensive its construction and sales activities.

Electricity Usage by Project

(kWh)



The chart on the side shows the electricity usage by Triniti Dinamik and its projects. The total electricity consumption across all Triniti Dinamik projects until Q3 2025 amounted to 2.172.996 kWh, with the highest usage recorded by District East (DE) at 1.189.985 kWh, while Springwood Residence (SW) and The Smith (TS) accounted for 983.011 kWh. The higher electricity consumption at DE was primarily due to its ongoing construction activities, whereas TS and SW are currently in the phase of selling their remaining unsold units, which requires less energy usage overall.
